

Ebooks on an Android device:

- Go to the *Android Market* on your phone and search for Overdrive Media Console. Install free app.
- Will ask you for your zip code to locate the library nearest you that has downloadable books available through Overdrive.
- Once you reach the OCLN network page of downloadable books, the first page has suggested books in the ebook and audiobook formats. Click on browse box at the top of the page or enter terms in search box. Only items that are in the right format to be used on an android phone will come up.
- Must set up an Adobe ID to check out a book; you will be prompted to do this when you check out and download a book. The android seems to remember the ID after first use – I did not have to enter it the next time I downloaded a book. After the identity is set up, you will have to reopen overdrive to continue.
- Go to My eAccount. Here you will see your eBookbag, eCheckouts, eAudio Holds, and Wish list. After setting up your Adobe ID, your item is probably waiting in the eBookbag. Once you have checked the book out, you can access it by going to your eCheckouts in your eAccount and downloading the book. When the book is finished downloading, a screen will appear with instructions on using your ebook. You can use the menu button to change the reader settings such as the brightness, and font and to navigate through the book.
- While eBooks can be checked in early, this must be done through Adobe Digital Editions, which is not available through the android market. It appears that checking in must be done on a computer, not on your device. Items will automatically disappear from your account after the two week checkout period, so check in is not necessary.
